Graduation Requirements

- A. Number of credits for graduation is 30, including :
- (1) 1 Required courses: **2** credits.
 - (2) 4 Seminars (I II, III, IV): **0** credit
 - (3) 3 Required selective courses:**6** credits
 - (4) Other selective courses: at least **10** credits
 - (5) Dissertation : **12** required credits
- B. NCKU PhD and Master students whom be admitted from 2022 Fall semester and after, need to take
- Courses of General Education:**
- (1) Academic Ethics at least 6hrs.
 - (2) Ability of Mandarin and English Writing at least 1hr.
 - (3) Ability of communication and expression at least 1hr.

Information about elective credits

- A. In general, each course is 2 credits. You have to select course to reach 18 credits. (Include 2 required credits, and 6 required selective credits.)
- B. After get advisor’s agreement, you can select another department credits. The course must for Doctor or Master/Doctor.

Information about seminar course

Seminar (1) (2) (3) (4) are required credits, each semester has select one course, and they're all 0 credit. This is the course below, and you should selected one for each semester.

A. First semester

1. Research Seminar(1)→This is for first year.
2. Research Seminar(3)→This is for second year.

B. Second semester

1. Research Seminar(2)→This is for first year.
2. Research Seminar(4)→This is for second year.

Select the **four** course before you graduate.

C. After second year, you also need to select the course **【Research Seminar】** which its name not contains(1)(2)(3)(4).

Information about Dissertation examination

A. The Ph.D. students need to complete the following requirements to apply dissertation examination.

1. Completed the graduation 18 elective credits. (Please hand in your transcript.)
2. Pass PhD Candidates qualification Exam. (**Choose 2 fields of interest**)
3. Pass PhD Dissertation proposal defense.
4. Oral present your progress report in English at least once.
5. Submit your research results to a related international conference.
6. Pass an English proficiency test, equivalent to or better than TOEIC 785.
7. **At least two first-author papers** related to your thesis should be accepted in the SCI/SSCI journals. (**One must rank $\leq 50\%$** in a selected category)

B. Dissertation is 12 required credits. PhD will get the credits by passing the examination.

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
